


## Theater

Theatrical life of Lublin requires no additional comments – just visit the theater halls – totally worth it. Therefore we give only some useful information on selected locations:

- **The Old Theater** – book tickets at least one month in advance - tickets “for tomorrow” are available for the train, but not for the show at the Old Theater.
- **Juliusz Osterwa Theater** – excellent actors and repertoire, reasonable price, fast ticket purchase on-line or by phone.
- **H. Ch. Andersen Theater** – great place to bring your children (or visit it by yourself, if you're a fan of toys and dolls).



## Festival time

- Saxophone, trumpet, double bass, bass guitar – yes, this is the **Lublin Jazz Festival** – recurring Lublin event presenting wide varieties of contemporary jazz music.
- 2:00 AM, crowds on the streets, street performances, music in every corner – this is how the **Lublin Night of Culture** looks. Every resident of Lublin should experience it at least once. The same can be said about **The Magicians Carnival [Carnaval Sztukmistrzów]**, when Lublin becomes a home to hundreds of artists from across Poland and Europe.



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

The fascination of the residents of the ‘goats’ city’ in art, music, theater and other forms of broad culture has resulted in the development of a substantial cultural infrastructure in the city. Probably there is “something” for everyone seeking cultural experiences.


## Visual experience

- **Biała Gallery in the CC; Labirynt Gallery** – sometimes it’s worth to wander, to seek a path in the winding lanes of contemporary art.
- Enthusiasts of the more traditional painting are to visit the **Lublin Museum** and climatic **art galleries** scattered around the Old Town.



## Music

- The **Musical Theatre** and **Philharmonic Hall** are great places for people who love music. Opera, musicals, ballet, concerts, musical comedy - all of this include powerful repertoires at these places.



- If you prefer to listen to music in the open air, it’s worth following the events of the **Concert Amphitheater „The Shell”** in Saxon Garden or take a walk to the **Bridge of Culture**. Positive emotions guaranteed (what is more – it’s for free).
- For the ones adoring a nighttime lifestyle the doors of dozens of clubs and pubs are wide open. It’s also worth checking the offer of a variety of festivals taking place in the city – you will be surprised how many there are.

## Sport

For those seeking some active leisure Lublin offers a whole range of sporting activities.

- **Arena Lublin** – modern city stadium hosting the biggest sporting events in the Lublin region, such as football, American football, rugby and others.
- **Aqua Lublin** – largest in the region and most modern pool complex in Poland. You will not pay much for the ticket, but will get lots of fun.
- **„Globus” Hall** – welcome to the stands of the largest in the region sports facility created for indoor sports. The most exciting handball, volleyball or basketball matches are held here.
- **Słoneczny Wrotków** – a complex of outdoor swimming pools located at **Zemborzyckie Lake [Zalew Zemborzycki]** – a fantastic place for hot summer days. Here you also can try out kayaks, water skiing, or even windsurfing.
- **Lublin Bike System** – you only need to log in to the system and top up your account. THAT’S IT! - From now on you have access to almost 900 bicycles available at 90 bike stations. What is more, first 20 minutes of rent is for free, and if you ride for one hour – you’ll pay only 1 zł.
- **Central Playground** – a fantastic initiative by the CC in Lublin, which allows to daily experience and learn something new. Here you can try some parkour tricks, experiment with street workout exercises, jump on a skateboard or BMX – adrenaline guaranteed (if the weather is nice).
